RESOLUTION NO. 2024-003

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ELECTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT A 2% SALES AND USE TAX FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:3078 authorized the St. George Transition District to levy a temporary 2% sales and use tax without the necessity of voter approval;

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2024, the St. George Transition District adopted a resolution to levy and collect a temporary 2% sales and use tax to replace the 2% sales and use tax which the Parish of East Baton Rouge had previously levied within the formerly unincorporated area of East Baton Rouge that is now incorporated as the City of St. George;

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:3079(D)(5) provides the St. George Transition District "shall cease existence, and any sales and use taxes levied by the district shall expire at such time as the municipality levies and collects a two percent sales and use tax, the end of the quarter following the election to impose the municipal tax if the proposition is not approved by the electorate, or twelve months after the incorporation becomes final, whichever occurs first"; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George seeks to call an election at the earliest date authorized by law to authorize the levy and collection of a 2% sales and use tax to replace the tax levied by the St. George Transition District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of St. George, it is the intention hereof to transfer the taxing authority from the St. George Transition District to the City of St. George without duplication of taxes levied within the City of St. George to be used for general municipal purposes:

Section 1. **Election Call**. Subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission, a special election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of St. George on SATURDAY, December 7, 2024, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law on the following proposition:

CITY OF ST. GEORGE

Shall the St. George City Council be authorized to levy and collect a tax of two percent (2%) ("Tax") upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption, the storage for use or consumption of tangible personal property and on sales of services, all as presently defined in La. R.S. 47:301 through La. R.S. 47:318, inclusive within the geographic boundaries of the City of St. George to

replace the current sales and use tax of equal amount to be used for general municipal purposes including but not limited to, acquiring, constructing, improving and maintaining public works with an estimated annual collection of \$48,000,000, the proceeds of said Tax to be subject to funding into bonds in the manner provided by law?

- **Section 2. Publication of Notice.** A Notice of Special Election shall be published in *The Advocate*, the official journal of the City of St. George, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than 45 days nor more than 90 days prior to the date fixed for election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form of Exhibit A attached hereto.
- **Section 3.** Canvass. St. George City Council will meet at its regular meeting place at 14100 Airline Hwy, Baton Rouge, LA 70817, on Tuesday, January 14, 2025 at 6:00 PM to will canvass the returns and declare the results of the election.
- Section 4. Authorization of Officers. The City Clerk is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to take any action required for the conduct of the election.
- Section 5. Notice to Election Officials. Certified copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Louisiana State Bond Commission and Secretary of State and to the Clerk of Court and the Registrar of Voters for East Baton Rouge Parish.
- Section 6. Application to State Bond Commission. Application shall be made to the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the aforesaid special election, and in the event said election carries, for consent to levy the sales and use taxes provided for therein.
- Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
