ORDINANCE NO. 2025-047

TO RENAME PORTIONS OF PECUE LANE AND PECUE BOULVDARD TO OLD PECUE LANE AND PECUE LANE AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, Approximately 15 years ago, two new 4-lane segments of Pecue Lane were constructed between Perkins Rd to Airline Hwy; and

WHEREAS, the new road segments were named Pecue Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, street naming is important for emergency response and public wayfinding; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that street names should only change at controlled intersections; and

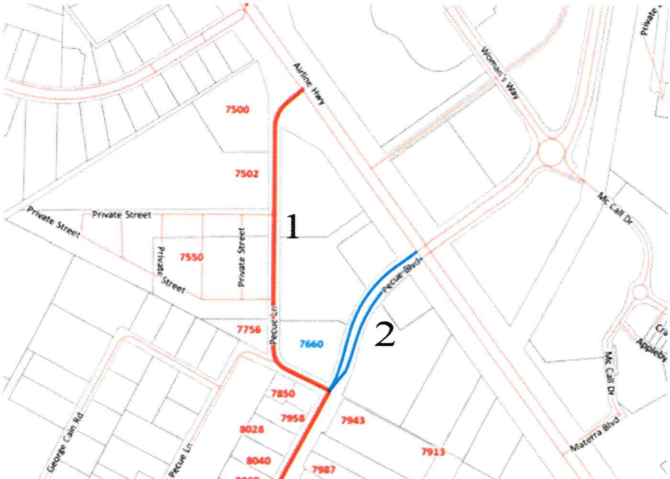
WHEREAS, the street name changes made herein have already been “accepted” as evidenced by DOTD signage and Google Maps labeling ; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 6, 2025, before the City of St. George Planning Commission, after which the Commission recommended changing the names of the roadway segments as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the St. George City Council, State of Louisiana, as follows:

Section 1: The portions of Pecue Lane and Pecue Boulevard identified in the chart and map below are hereby changed as set forth in the chart.

Section 2: Conflicts. The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3: Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
