A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DEBRIS & EMERGENCY
MEASURES INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE AND PARISH OF
EAST BATON ROUGE, THE ST. GEORGE TRANSITION
DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE AND TO PROVIDE
FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge (“City-Parish”) have propositioned contracts for emergency preparation and debris removal services;

WHEREAS, as a result of Hurricane Francine Mayor-President Sharon Weston Broome activated the emergency contracts;

WHEREAS, St. George seeks to obtain emergency preparation and debris removal services for Hurricane Francine and future emergencies through the City-Parish until the City of St. George is issued a community identification number by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council for the City of St. George that Mayor Dustin Yates is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Baton Rouge and the Parish of East Baton Rouge, the St. George Transition District and the City of St. George for Debris and Emergency Measures for emergency preparation and debris removal services.
