WHEREAS the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires municipalities to prepare a hazard mitigation plan as a precondition for receiving FEMA mitigation funds for certain types of non-emergency disaster assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act and the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968;

WHEREAS the St. George Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of St. George and seeks to adopt a hazard mitigation plan that demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George received proposals from firms to provide professional services to assist the City in preparing a multi-hazard mitigation plan, in accordance with the requirements of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, Pre-Disaster Mitigation, Flood Mitigation Assistance, and other federal or state programs related to hazard mitigation planning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the St. George City Council, hereby authorizes and empowers Mayor Yates to negotiate and execute a professional services agreement with Metric Consulting, LLC for development of a Hazard Mitigation Plan.
