CITY COUNCIL ELECTION DISTRICT DESCRIPTIONS AND TO PROVIDE FOR 10 11 **RELATED MATTERS** 12 13 WHEREAS, the creation of the City of St. George was approved by the voters on October 14 19, 2019: 15 WHEREAS, Governor Jeff Landry appointed the initial representatives for the City of St. 16 George on May 23, 2024, which consisted of three single-member districts and two at-large 17 18 representatives; 19 WHEREAS, Title 32 of Louisiana Revised Statutes, provides that the boundaries of a 20 21 municipality's election districts are determined based on the federal decennial census by the 22 Census Bureau: 23 24 WHEREAS, in preparation for the first election of representatives for the City of St. 25 George on March 29, 2025, the Mayor and St. George City Council have engaged or caused to be engaged a professional consultant to assist in the development of the City's inaugural municipal 26 27 election districts based upon the 2020 Census counts. 28 29 WHEREAS, the St. George City Council, after considering several apportionment plans at 30 public meetings held for that purpose, has determined that Plan A, a derivative of draft Plan 4-5 that was presented and discussed at the second districting workshop, is the most equitable for the 31 32 City of St. George. 33 34 WHEREAS, the St. George City Council wishes to formally apportion the City of St. 35 George into election districts, by adopting Plan A, attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A 36 37 BE IT ORDAINED by the St. George City Council, State of Louisiana, the following plan 38 of apportionment for the single-member election districts for the City of St. George is adopted and
