The following Resolution was offered by Council Member Cook:

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-011

TO SELECT *THE ADVOCATE* TO CONTINUE AS THE OFFICIAL JOURNAL FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICES REQUIRED BY LAW AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 43:141 requires municipal corporations to select a newspaper as their official journal for publication of all notices required by law for a term of one year;

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 43:141, *et seq.* sets forth the requirements for a newspaper to be selected as an official journal of a municipal corporation, which include having been “published in an office physically located in the parish in which the body is located for a period of two years preceding the selection” La. R.S. 43:142;

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2024-002, *The Advocate* was selected as the Official Journal for the City of St. George through the first meeting of the St. George City Council in June of 2025; and

WHEREAS, *The Advocate*, located at 10705 Rieger Road, Baton Rouge, LA 70809, is the only newspaper meeting all of the requirements set forth in La. R.S. La. R.S. 43:141, *et seq.*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. George City Council hereby selects *The Advocate* as the Official Journal of the City of St. George for publication of all notices required by law from the expiration of Resolution No. 2024-002 until the first meeting of the St. George City Council in June of 2026; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution, as adopted, be submitted the Office of the Secretary of State for recordation.
