RESOLUTION NO. 2026-014

TO APPOINT TUCKER SHARER AS A RESERVE OFFICER
FOR THE ST. GEORGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO
PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, R.S. 33:423(A) requires “a chief of police elected by the qualified voters” to “make recommendations to the mayor and board of aldermen for appointment of police personnel”;

WHEREAS, R.S. 33:423(2)(a) authorizes an elected chief of polices “to make a provision appointment to immediately fill any vacancy on the police department ... subject tot he approval of the mayor”;

WHEREAS, Chief of Police, Todd Morris, reviewed the qualifications of Tucker Sharer and recommended his appointment to the position of Reserve Officer with the St. George Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the St. George City Council desires to appoint Tucker Sharer as a part-time Reserve Officer for the St. George Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the St. George City Council that the appointment of Tucker Sharer as a Reserve Officer for the St. George Police Department is hereby approved.
