RESOLUTION NO. 2026-010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE TO COMMIT TO A TWENTY PERCENT (20%) LOCAL MATCH FOR THE BLUEBONNET SIDEWALK INITIATIVE UNDER THE CAPITAL REGION PLANNING COMMISSION CARBON REDUCTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Capital Region Planning Commission administers the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP), a federally funded program designed to reduce transportation emissions, improve air quality, and support safer, more efficient transportation systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George has identified the Bluebonnet Boulevard corridor as a high-traffic area with limited pedestrian infrastructure, creating safety concerns and contributing to unnecessary vehicle trips and congestion; and

WHEREAS, the Bluebonnet Sidewalk Initiative will construct sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, signage, landscaping, and related improvements to enhance safety, improve traffic flow by reducing short vehicle trips, and provide safer, more reliable access for residents, businesses, and visitors along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is \$458,950; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George is required to provide a twenty percent (20%) local match for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George desires to commit to providing a local match in an amount not to exceed \$91,790 from legally available funds; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of St. George desires to formally confirm its commitment to providing the required local match to support this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of St. George, that:

SECTION 1.

The Council hereby commits to providing a twenty percent (20%) local match in an amount not to exceed \$91,790, from legally available funds, for the Bluebonnet Sidewalk Initiative under the Capital Region Planning Commission Carbon Reduction Program.

SECTION 2.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption. This Resolution having been submitted to vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
