**RESOLUTION 2026-017**

**TO APPOINT ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION HEARING OFFICER  
AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

**WHEREAS**, La. R.S. 13:2575, *et seq.* provides the Council for the City of St. George with the authority to prescribe civil fines for violation of public health, housing, fire code, environmental, and historic district ordinances, blighted property, or abandoned property in the municipality and adopt ordinances for administrative adjudication procedures regarding such violations.

**WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2024 the Council adopted Ordinance No. 2024-024, which adopted Title 4. Administrative Adjudication, Chapter 1. Administrative Adjudication Procedure, Sections 4:103 through 4:105, which provided for the appointment, powers, and authority of administrative adjudication hearing officers;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has reviewed the qualifications of Kenneth H. Hooks, III, and recommends his appointment as an administrative adjudication hearing officer subject to his taking an oath of office;

**WHEREAS**, the Council desires to approve the appointment of Kenneth H. Hooks, III, as an administrative adjudication hearing officer.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the St. George City Council, State of Louisiana that the appointment of Kenneth H. Hooks, III, as an administrative adjudication hearing officer subject to his taking an oath of office is hereby approved.
