RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 022

**TO APPROVE THE SELECTION OF THOMPSON CONSULTING SERVICES
TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL DISASTER RECOVERY PROJECT MANAGEMENT
AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the City of St. George issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Professional Disaster Recovery Project Management Services in accordance with applicable local, state, and federal procurement requirements;

WHEREAS, proposals submitted in response to the RFP were evaluated by the City's selection committee based upon qualifications, experience, technical capabilities, staffing capacity, past performance, and pricing;

WHEREAS, Thompson Consulting Services was determined to be the most qualified and responsive proposer and possesses the expertise, resources, and experience necessary to provide professional disaster recovery project management services to the City;

WHEREAS, such services may include disaster recovery planning, project formulation and management, grant administration support, FEMA Public Assistance program support, hazard mitigation assistance, federal and state funding compliance, damage assessment coordination, cost recovery, and other related disaster recovery consulting services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that entering into a contract with Thompson Consulting Services is in the best interest of the City of St. George and its residents and will enhance the City's ability to recover efficiently from disaster events while maximizing available federal and state reimbursement opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the St. George City Council, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the selection of Thompson Consulting Services to provide Professional Disaster Recovery Project Management Services for the City of St. George.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and deliver on behalf of the City of St. George a contract with Thompson Consulting Services for Professional Disaster Recovery Project Management Services, together with any related documents, work authorizations, amendments, certifications, renewals, and other instruments necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, City Clerk, and all other appropriate City officials are authorized to take any and all actions necessary to implement this Resolution and fulfill the City's obligations under the contract.
