RESOLUTION NO. 2026 – 023

TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXTEND, FOR ONE YEAR (JULY 1, 2026 – JUNE 30, 2027), THE TRAFFIC SIGNALS MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE AND PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA AND THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2026, the City of St. George, Louisiana entered into a Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement with the City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana, which provided for the maintenance and operation of traffic signals and signal systems within the city limits of the City of St. George, Louisiana;

WHEREAS, the term of the Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement will expire on June 30, 2026;

WHEREAS, the maintenance and operation of traffic signals (controller, cabinet, heads, loops, and etc.) and signal systems (interconnect, modems, telecommunication drops, central computers, and etc.) are necessary for safe and efficient travel and highway transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that extending the Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement is in the best interest of the City of St. George and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. George, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the extension of the Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement with the City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana for one (1) year (July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027) for the maintenance and operation of traffic signals and signal systems within the city limits of the City of St. George.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any documents, amendments, certifications, renewals, or ancillary agreements necessary to extend the terms and conditions of the Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, City Clerk, Public Works personnel, and all other appropriate City officials are authorized to take any actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution and fulfill the obligations of the City of St. George, Louisiana under the Traffic Signals Maintenance Agreement.
