WHEREAS, the following bids were received in accordance with Louisiana Public Bid Law for such work by the City of St. George within the time allowed for submission in the advertisement therefore:

Section 1: The City Council hereby accepts the lowest bid of R.J Daigle and Sons Contractors, Inc, in the sum of \$835,885.25 for the Elliot Road Rehabilitation project and awards the contract to the lowest bidder, R.J Daigle and Sons Contractors, Inc.

Section 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of St. George, a contract with R.J Daigle and Sons Contractors, Inc. for the Elliot Road Rehabilitation project, together with any related documents, amendments, renewals, task orders, and certifications necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

Section 3: The Mayor, City Clerk, and all other appropriate City officials are authorized to take any and all actions necessary to implement this Resolution and fulfill the City's obligations under this contract.
